



Grantwood Golf Course is always striving to promote a healthy and safe environment for all of our employees, our community members and golfers. During this time, all businesses and social norms are adapting to changes to help stop the spread of COVID-19. Please read below the policy changes and cleaning practices we are observing in correlation to the Ohio Health Department, Cuyahoga County Board of Health and the U.S. Department of Health & Human Services.

- Employees are required to practice Social Distancing while in all buildings and outside.
- While on tees, greens and all other areas of the property, golfers and staff are required to stay a minimum of 6 feet apart.
- Grantwood's Driving Range is cleaned and sanitized throughout the day by staff members. Stalls, inside and outside, are 8 to 10 feet apart to promote a safe and healthy experience.
- It is recommended one golfer pays per group to limit contact.
- All Grantwood staff members are required to wear protected gloves and clean all areas after coming in contact with golfers or staff members. Approved masks are also provided by Grantwood Golf Course for staff members.
- Maintenance staff is required to wear protective gloves and sanitize all equipment before and after every use. Staff is required to practice social distancing while working on the course and Range.
- Grantwood's Snack Bar will not be open until further notice, but closed beverages and snacks may be purchased when paying for your round.
- Golfers are allowed to ride two to a golf cart as state by the Ohio Health Department in the Responsible Restart Ohio operating requirements.
- All golfers are required to clean out the golf cart used after their round. All trash must be disposed in the appropriate containers by the golfer.
- Grantwood Golf Course staff will clean each cart with disinfecting cleaners after trash has been removed from the cart.
- Staff members will clean all parts of carts which have or might have come in contact with the public such as seats, cubbies, hand rails, steering wheel, bag holder, basket, pull down canopy and various other parts which might have come in contact with the public from the last cleaning.
- The staff has removed common touchable surfaces (water coolers, bunker rakes, ball washers, etc.) on the property.
- Modifications have been made so the flagstick does not need to be removed to retrieve the ball. Grantwood uses a foam noodle stopping the ball approximately 1 inch below the green surface. The ball goes into the cup and can be lifted using the putter head. The flagstick remains lodged in the cup through the hole in the noodle.

Thank you for understanding the changes with our current policies during this time. As new information as well as health and safety practices are recommended, Grantwood Golf Course will continue to adapt and follow all practices recommended
