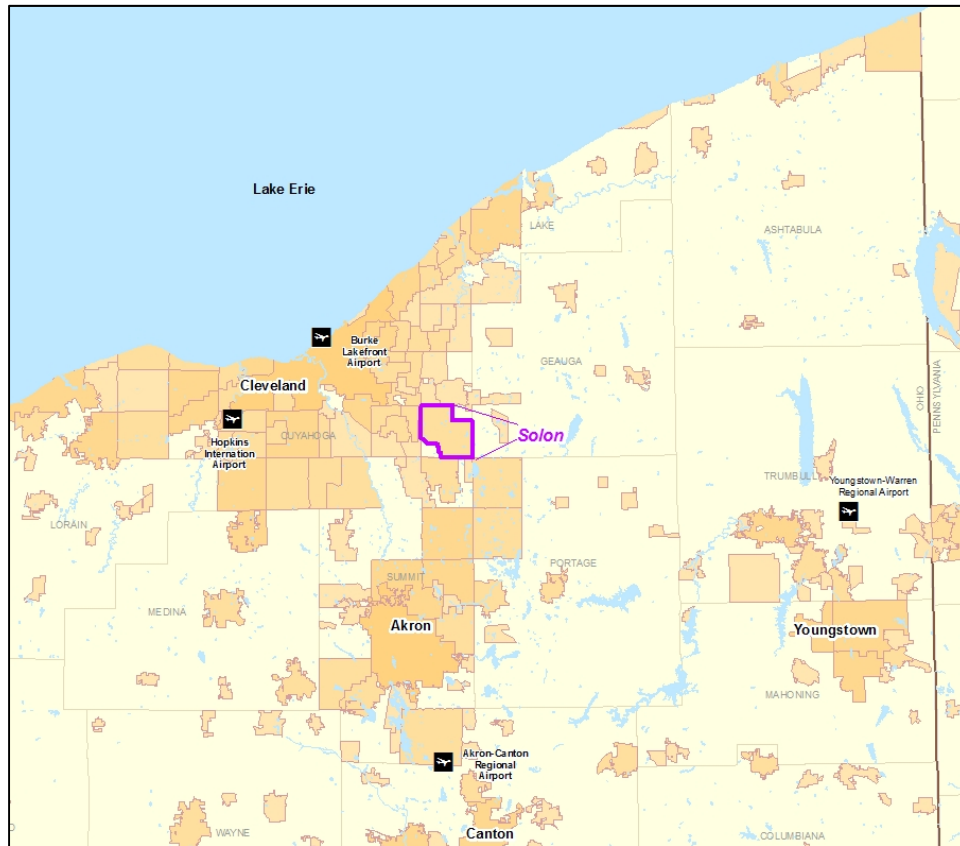

The City of Solon is a diverse suburban community of approximately 23,000 residents located in northeast Ohio. The City is situated in the southeast corner of Cuyahoga County, approximately fifteen (15) miles from downtown Cleveland. US 422, a regional, divided four lane highway, bisects the city providing quick and convenient access to several nearby interstate highways.
